9. **Valor Acres Phase II TIF** – an Ordinance creating the Valor Acres Phase II TIF pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41, 5709.42 and 5709.43, declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, and requiring the owners of the improvements on such parcels to make service payments in lieu of taxes.
10. **TIF Ordinance** – an Ordinance creating an incentive district pursuant to RC Sections 5709.40(C), 5709.42 and 5709.43, declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, requiring the owners of the improvements on such parcels to make service payments in lieu if taxes, and providing for the use of such service payments.
