**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING CONDOLENCES
TO THE FAMILY OF DAVID J. DEUCH
AND COMMENDING HIS CONTRIBUTION

AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, upon the passing of David J. Deuch, Mayor Hruby and the Members Of Council wish to memorialize and commend his many contributions to the City of Brecksville, and to extend the most sincere condolences to his family; and

WHEREAS, David Deuch served as a Brecksville City Councilmember from January 2, 1998 to January 1, 2010, when he did not seek re-election. During his tenure as Councilmember, he served as Vice President of Council in 2002 and 2003 and President of Council in 2004 and 2005. In addition he served as Chair of the Legislation Committee and Chair of the Finance Committee. He also served as member of the Buildings & Grounds, Safety Service, Streets & Sidewalks, and Utilities Committees; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Deuch served as Council Representative to the Recreation Commission and the Planning Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Councilmember Deuch unselfishly and devotedly served the City of Brecksville, giving of his time and knowledge for the betterment of the community he loved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Council wish to extend their most sincere condolences and heartfelt sympathies to the family of David J. Deuch: his wife Joan, son Jeffrey and his wife Kathleen, daughter Dariene Wasser and David and Joan's grandchildren.

SECTION 2. Upon this sad occasion, the Mayor and Council urge all residents to remember and reflect upon the contribution made by David J. Deuch during his service to the Brecksville City Council and to memorialize his lasting contribution.
