**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT
NO. 20-5274 TO INCREASE THE HOURLY PAY RATE FOR ALL
TEMPORARY GENERAL LABOR STAFFING FOR THE SERVICE
DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, at its meeting on December 3, 2019, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 5274 accepting the bid of Safe Staffing of Ohio for temporary general labor staffing and rubbish/recycle/leaf collection staffing for the Service Department for the year 2020; and

WHEREAS, an Extension of Agreement No. 20-5274, dated November 3, 2020, between the City of Brecksville and Safe Staffing of Ohio was approved by City Council for the year 2021; and

WHEREAS, due to COVID-19, the Service Department has been operating without temporary general labor staffing from Safe Staffing; and

WHEREAS, Safe Staffing has confirmed that they are unable to consistently place temporary workers for less than a \$15/hour rate; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing and the Service Director recommend amending the Extension Agreement with Safe Staffing to increase the hourly pay rate for all temporary general labor staffing for the Service Department to \$15.00/hour resulting in an hourly bill rate to the city of \$19.65/hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Extension of Agreement No. 20-5274, be, and the same hereby is, amended to increase the hourly pay rate for all temporary general labor staffing for the service department to \$15.00/hour resulting in an hourly bill rate to the city of \$19.65/hour, a copy of which Extension of Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.



The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need for temporary staffing, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
