WHEREAS, Lt. Zimlich has been responsible for all radio equipment and was the liaison with emergency dispatchers and performed many administrative duties, always with great attention to detail; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Zimlich saved lives, bravely fought fires, rescued persons, promoted fire safety and fire prevention, supervised and administered all aspects of the department in his role as a Lieutenant and day after day risked his life to the benefit of others and in doing so created positive and favorable public relations and contributed towards the image building of the Brecksville Fire Department to those they served.


and family who shared this fine man with the City of Brecksville for more than 30 years.


SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council be and she is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution and cause the delivery of same to Brian Zimlich.
