Ordinance No. 5441

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF  
WR RESTORATION FOR THE BRECKSVILLE  
COMMUNITY CENTER WALL INSPECTION  
AND RESTORATION PROJECT; AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the publication of bids according to law, bids for the Brecksville Community Center Wall Inspection and Restoration Project in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing, were received and opened according to law at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 17, 2021, and it being determined that the bid of WR Restoration was the lowest and best bid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The bid of WR Restoration for the Brecksville Community Center Wall Inspection and Restoration Project in an amount not to exceed sixty-four thousand, six hundred eighty-six dollars (\$64,686.00), and approving various unit prices for Add & Deduct applications, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.


**SECTION 2.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with WR Restoration as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

**SECTION 3.** The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

**SECTION 4.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need for the wall inspection & restoration, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
