**A RESOLUTION DOCUMENTING AND  
DECLARING THE USE AND EXPENDITURES  
OF CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL  
RECOVERY FUNDS RECEIVED THROUGH  
THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT BY THE  
CITY OF BRECKSVILLE; AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brecksville has received Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

**WHEREAS**, SLFRF provide needed fiscal relief for recipients that have experienced revenue loss due to the onset of the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, recipients may elect a “standard allowance” of ten million dollars to spend on government services through the performance period; and

**WHEREAS**, under the standard allowance option the U.S. Department of the Treasury presumes that up to ten million dollars in revenue has been lost due to the public health emergency and recipients are permitted to use that amount (not to exceed the award amount) to fund “government services”; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council wishes to elect the standard allowance option and to document and declare the government services expenditures of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Council of the City of Brecksville hereby documents and declares the use of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act by the City of Brecksville to be for the replacement of lost public sector revenue through the standard allowance election.

**SECTION 2.** The Council of the City of Brecksville hereby documents and declares the expenditure of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act by the City of Brecksville to be for government services.

**SECTION 3.** The Council of the City of Brecksville further clarifies the City’s expenditure of funds for government services as being used towards salaries, wages and related benefits of the City’s Police Department.


**SECTION 4.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it is necessary to document and declare expenditures in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
