Ordinance No. 5578

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.19 OF
THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CHANGE THE
FLAT RATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville,
County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Section 145.19 of the Administrative Code be amended to read as follows:

“145.19 FIREMEN; OFFICER-IN-CHARGE PREMIUM.


Effective December 18, 2022, Any fireman who is performing the duties and assuming the responsibility of Officer-in-Charge for at least twelve (12) hours of a regular tour of duty in the absence of a Lieutenant, shall be compensated at a flat rate of ~~\$30~~ \$60 for each tour of duty worked. The Office-in-Charge shall be the senior fireman normally assigned to work the tour of duty unless the Chief designates said shift with an Officer-in Charge in advance.”

SECTION 2. Section 145.19 of the Administrative Code as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance and all other ordinances or resolutions inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is to change the flat rate, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


