**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF  
THREE (3) 2022 FORD SUV INTERCEPTORS FOR USE  
BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM MONTROSE  
FORD THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE  
SERVICES PURCHASING PROGRAM AND EMERGENCY  
EQUIPMENT & LABOR FOR CHANGEOVER SERVICES  
FROM HALL PUBLIC SAFETY UPFITTERS IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF  
OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 125.04(C) AND  
NON-STATE CONTRACT VEHICLE GRAPHICS;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville deems it cost effective to purchase certain equipment through the State of Ohio, Administrative Services Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04(C) of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville has determined that it is cost effective to purchase equipment for use by the Police Department from Hall Public Safety Upfitters based upon equivalent State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services – State Purchasing Contract terms, conditions, and specifications, but at a lower price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services - State Purchasing, through its authorized vendor, Montrose Ford for the purchase of three (3) 2022 Ford SUV Interceptors for use by the Police Department:

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Hall Public Safety Upfitters for the purchase of emergency equipment, accessories and labor for changeover services in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C) and Non-State Contract vehicle graphics:

**SECTION 3.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Montrose Ford and Hall Public Safety Uptfitters as set forth in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, said contracts to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

**SECTION 4.** The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

**SECTION 5.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the Police Department's need for the vehicles, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
