**WHEREAS**, throughout his unprecedented 32 years of service on City Council, Louis Carouse, Jr. served as City Council Vice-President from January 2, 1994 through January 1, 1998, and City Council President from January 2, 1998 through January 1, 2000; and

**WHEREAS**, Louis Carouse, Jr. served as Chair Member of Safety Service Committee from January 2, 2000 through January 1, 2002 and again from January 2, 2018 through January 1, 2022, Chair Member of Utilities Committee from January 2, 2002 through January 1, 2008 and again from January 2, 2016 through January 1, 2018, Chair Member of Legislation Committee from January 2, 2008 through January 1, 2010, and Chair Member of Buildings and Grounds Committee from January 2, 2010 through January 1, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure as a Councilmember, was also a member of the Buildings and Grounds Committee, Finance Committee, Legislation Committee, Safety Service Committee, Streets and Sidewalks Committee, and Utilities Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Louis Carouse, Jr served as a City Council Representative to the Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board from January 2, 2000 through January 1, 2004, January 2, 2006 through January 1, 2012, and again from January 2, 2018 through January 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as a City Council Representative to the Recreation Commission from January 2, 2004 through January 1, 2006, Human Services Advisory Board from January 2, 1993 through January 1, 1998, and January 2, 2012 through January 1, 2014, Community Center Registration and Use Review Board from January 2, 2002 through January 1, 2008, and the Municipal Facility Registration and Use Review Board from January 2, 2006 through January 1, 2014, and January 2, 2016 through January 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Louis Carouse, Jr. served as a City Council Representative to the Income Tax Review Board from January 2, 1993 through January 1, 1994, January 2, 1997 through January 1, 1998, and again from January 2, 2016 through January 1, 2018, Telecommunications Commission from January 2, 2006 through January 1, 2010, and January 2, 2020 through January 1, 2022, and the Planning Commission from January 2, 1990 through January 1, 1992; and


