Ordinance No. 5516

**A ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID
OF CARGILL, INC. FOR SODIUM CHLORIDE
FOR USE BY THE CITY OF BRECKSVILLE
SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE JOINT
MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT CONSORTIUM;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Brecksville may purchase sodium chloride through its membership in the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium at a lower cost; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium, the City of Brecksville, pursuant to publication according to law, solicited bids for the provision of sodium chloride for the period November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City of Brecksville Director of Purchasing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said publication, bids were received and opened according to law at 9:00 A.M. on Friday, May 20, 2022, and it being determined that the bid of Cargill, Inc. was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The bid of Cargill, Inc. dated May 20, 2022, through the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium, for sodium chloride for use by the Service Department of the City of Brecksville for the period November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023 in the following amounts:

Untreated Sodium Chloride:
\$52.21 per ton, dump delivery
\$59.21 per ton, piler delivery

Treated Sodium Chloride:
\$68.32 per ton, dump delivery
\$75.32 per ton, piler delivery,

with an option to renew at a negotiated cost for the second year and third year, and in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City of Brecksville Director of Purchasing be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Cargill, Inc. as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof; and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.


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SECTION 4. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the Service Department's need for sodium chloride, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
