**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP  
OF "PETO" THE CITY'S RETIRED POLICE DOG TO HIS HANDLER,  
SGT. MICHAEL BAUMAN, FOR THE SUM OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00)  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 9.62 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the city's police dog, "Peto" has reached that point in his career where a well-deserved retirement is in order;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 9.62 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville desires to facilitate Peto's retirement by transferring ownership to his handler, Sgt. Michael Bauman, for the sum of one dollar (\$1.00).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and hereby is authorized to transfer ownership of the city's police dog, Peto, to his handler, Sgt. Michael Bauman, for the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 9.62 of the Ohio Revised Code. Further, the City of Brecksville wishes Peto a long and healthy retirement and extends its appreciation to Peto and his handler for a job well done.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized to receive the funds as provided in Section 1 hereof, said amount to be credited to the appropriately designated Fund.

**SECTION 3.** The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is it relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
