**RESOLUTION OF AND EXPRESSIONS OF CONDOLENCES
OVER THE PASSING OF FORMER
BRECKSVILLE MAYOR ROBERT L. KUBICEK**

WHEREAS; On May 1, 2022, surrounded by his loving family, Robert L. Kubicek passed away after a short illness at the age of 96; and

WHEREAS; Robert L. Kubicek first served the Village of Brecksville as a Council Member from 1956 to 1960, including President of City Council, then served as Brecksville's 5th Mayor from 1960 to 1964. During Mayor Kubicek's first year of office, the Village of Brecksville became the City of Brecksville; followed by many milestones during his two terms as Mayor; The Veteran's Administration Hospital was dedicated, the Brecksville Shopping Center began its initial development, further business development and a "boom" in housing development,

WHEREAS; Robert grew up in Brecksville, where he graduated from Brecksville High School, was known for his excellent achievements, academic, student leadership and athletic accomplishments lettering in four sports and serving as President of Student Council; and a graduate of Rensselaer Polytechnic Insitute, and

WHEREAS; Robert deserves our gratitude and appreciation for his bravery, dedication and unselfish service in the United States Navy during WWII; and

WHEREAS; Robert was married to the love of his life, sweetheart, companion since Junior High School, Carol Grem of Brecksville, for 74 years, and from that marriage, they were blessed with daughters Kathleen, Beth, and Barbara, and many wonderful grandchildren; and

WHEREAS; at the request of Mayor Jerry N. Hruby, Robert became re-engaged with the City Government, agreeing to be an advisor to the Brecksville Bicentennial 2011 celebration and served as Grand Marshall of the Bicentennial Parade as well as standing at the side of Mayor Hruby throughout all Bicentennial events; mirroring his roles as Mayor during the Brecksville Sesquicentennial 1961, and he proudly rode in both parades 1961 and 2011 with his wife and daughters, and Robert L. Kubicek will continue to be recognized for his many contributions to this City, a hometown boy who gave back to his community, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR JERRY N. HRUBY THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Council do extend their most sincere condolences and heartfelt sympathies to the family and friends of Robert L. Kubicek.

SECTION 2. Upon this sad occasion the Mayor and Council do call upon all residents to remember and reflect upon the many contributions made by Robert L. Kubicek and memorialize his lasting contributions throughout the City of Brecksville.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
