A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT PROGRAM FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO IMPROVE STAFFING AND DEPLOYMENT CAPABILITES TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the objectives of the SAFER Program are to assist local fire departments with staffing and deployment capabilities to respond to emergencies and ensure that communities have adequate protection from fire and fire-related hazards.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), on behalf of the City of Brecksville, for a grant through the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant Program for funding assistance to improve staffing and deployment capabilities to respond to emergencies. The Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents are needed in furtherance of this grant application. In addition, in the event the City of Brecksville is successful in securing this grant, the Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents and to take the necessary steps to effectuate the receipt of these grant funds and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to credit the proceeds of any grant to the appropriately designated Fund.


SECTION 2. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is to make a timely application, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


