Ordinance No. 5263

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5253  
TO CHANGE THE TRADE IN VALUE OF POLICE  
FIRING RANGE ACCESSORIES, NO LONGER NEEDED  
FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, TO PRO ARMAMENT;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting on June 18, 2019, the Mayor and Council adopted Ordinance No. 5253 authorizing the trade of police firing range accessories no longer needed for municipal purposes to Pro Armament; and

**WHEREAS**, certain accessories were found to be inoperable and costly to repair and Pro Armament revised their quote for store credit.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1. of Ordinance No. 5253 be revised to read as follows:

**"SECTION 1.** The Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to trade in the following equipment no longer needed for a municipal purpose to Pro Armament for store credit in the amount of \$1,000.00 \$500.00:


- 1) ~~12~~ - EOTech rifle optics
- 2) ~~1~~ 3 - Simunition Colt 1911 conversion kits
- 3) ~~2~~ - Simunition Sig Sauer P225 conversion kits
- 4) ~~3~~ 13 - Benelli M1 Super 90 forends
- 5) ~~4~~ 1 - Surefire 617F-A Tactical Light for Benelli S90 Shotgun
- 6) ~~5~~ 1 - Surefire 618 Tactical Light for Remington 870 Shotgun
- 7) ~~6~~ 1 -- C.M.&T Company stock for Marlin 9mm & .45 Carbine"


**SECTION 2.** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 5253 shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency relates to the need to dispose of the outdated equipment, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


