Ordinance No. 5266

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 5220,  
MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT  
EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF BRECKSVILLE  
DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
DECEMBER 31, 2019, MAKING NECESSARY  
APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ADJUSTMENTS;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the appropriations heretofore set to certain accounts of the City of Brecksville are insufficient to pay expenses incurred during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 5220 passed December 18, 2018 making appropriations for expenses for the year 2019 is hereby amended as indicated herein below.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance be authorized to increase and decrease the appropriations in the General Fund:



**SECTION 3.** That the Director of Finance be authorized to increase the appropriations in the Compensated Absences Fund:

**SECTION 4.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it is necessary to make adjustments to appropriations of the City, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


