Ordinance No. 5293

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
DESTRUCTION OF THIRTY BALLISTIC
VESTS NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT FOR A MUNICIPAL PURPOSE;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Article II, Municipal Powers, of the Charter of the City of Brecksville provides that the Council may exercise powers in such manner as Council may determine as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, Chief of Police, and Council have determined that surplus and obsolete Police Department ballistic vests are no longer needed for a municipal purpose, however, such obsolete equipment should not be sold at auction or through other normal processes because of the potential concern for interference with Police Department operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. The Public Services Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to destroy thirty (30) ballistic vests as described in the attached Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if by reference and which is surplus, obsolete, and no longer needed for a municipal purpose, but cannot, however, be disposed of through normal sale or auction processes due to the potential for interference with Police Department operations.


SECTION 2. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



Dear Sir:

I respectfully request that we seek approval from Brecksville City Council at the January 21, 2020 Council Meeting to destroy and dispose of a total of thirty (30) old ballistic vests that are no longer in use or needed by the Brecksville Police Department. These vests have all been replaced, are well past their recommended age of use, and are no longer warranted for use by industry standards. I recommend that these vests be destroyed and disposed of rather than auctioning them off so that they do not end up in the wrong hands and/or create a possible liability for the City in any way. If approved, the Police Department will coordinate with the Service Department to ensure that the vests are destroyed and disposed of properly.

It is requested that a total of thirty (30) vests be destroyed and disposed of. Twenty-three (23) of the vests are standard duty vests and seven (7) of the vests are tactical vests.
