**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
ENTER INTO A PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
FOR THE ET3 PROGRAM (EMERGENCY TRIAGE,
TREAT, AND TRANSPORT) WITH THE CENTERS
FOR MEDICARE & MEDICAID SERVICES (CMS);
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, CMS is the agency within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services that is charged with administering the Medicare and Medicaid programs; and

WHEREAS, CMS is implementing the ET3 Model to test innovative payment and service delivery models that have the potential to reduce Medicare, Medicaid, or Children's Health Insurance Program expenditures while maintaining or improving quality of care; and

WHEREAS, the Brecksville Fire Department has been selected by CMS for the ET3 program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into a Participation Agreement for the ET3 Program (Emergency Triage, Treat, and Transport) with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, a copy of which Participation Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and expressly made a part of hereof by reference.


SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the necessity to provide the highest level of EMS care through the ET3 Program, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
