Resolution No. 5067

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DARYL KINGSTON
TO FILL THE VACANT COUNCIL OFFICE LEFT BY THE
REMOVAL OF JACK PETSCHER FOR THE TERM ENDING
JANUARY 1, 2022; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Jack Petsche was removed from his office as a City of Brecksville Council Member, effective July 22, 2020, for the term ending January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.43 provides that the vacancy shall be filled by election by the legislative authority for the unexpired term. If the legislative authority fails within thirty days to fill such vacancy, the Mayor shall fill it by appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council interviewed persons interested in filling the vacancy and who meet the qualifications required by Ohio Revised Code Section 731.13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. This Council hereby appoints Daryl Kingston to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term, or until January 1, 2022, left by the removal of Jack Petsche.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of the City of Brecksville is hereby directed to notify the Ohio Secretary of State and the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections of the removal of Jack Petsche and the appointment of Daryl Kingston to fill the unexpired term.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency being that said appointment is necessary to timely fill the Council vacancy, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


