Resolution No. 5101

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO APPLY FOR AN OHIO EPA COMMUNITY AND
LITTER GRANT THROUGH THE 2021 RECYCLING
AND LITTER PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR A BALER
WITH CONVEYOR INCLUDING INSTALLATION FOR
THE CITY'S RECYCLE CENTER; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the 2021 Recycling and Litter Prevention Program supports communities, businesses and academic institutions that initiate or expand recycling programs, encourage sustainable practices, stimulate economic growth and support litter prevention efforts through grants; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA Community and Litter Grant program requires the City to provide a twenty-five percent (25%) financial match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Brecksville to prepare and execute an application for an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Community and Litter Grant for the purchase of a new baler and conveyor, including installation, for the City's Recycle Center and to submit same to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for consideration of funding, which will require the City to provide a twenty-five percent (25%) financial match.

SECTION 2. If the application is approved for funding, the Mayor is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Brecksville to enter into a contract with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to purchase above described equipment.

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 4. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is to make a timely application, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




