Ordinance No. 5366

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF
FIFTEEN (15) CAMERAS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FROM
AFFINITECH FOR THE AQUATICS CENTER THROUGH
THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION
PURCHASING PROGRAM; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II of its Charter, the City of Brecksville may exercise its power of local self-government through the enactments of the Council; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 17, 2015, the Council approved Resolution No. 4527 authorizing the Director of Purchasing to register with the General Services Administration and to use such agency as a resource for the City's competitive information technology and security needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brecksville deems it cost effective and in the City's best interest to purchase certain equipment through the General Services Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Affinitech, an authorized General Services Administration vendor, for the purchase of fifteen (15) cameras and related equipment for the Aquatics Center, at a cost of seventeen thousand, three hundred twelve dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$17,312.98).

SECTION 2. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Affinitech as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.


SECTION 4. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need for the cameras and equipment for the Aquatics Center, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


