Job Summary:

Under the general direction of the Tree Warden/Horticulturalist, performs landscaping duties around municipal buildings and planting beds throughout the City.

Class Characteristics:

This is a seasonal employment position.

Essential Functions:

Plant, spray, weed, fertilize and water flowers, shrubs, trees, using hand tools and gardening tools.

Care for established planting beds by mulching, weeding and edging.

Inspect flowers and plants to detect presence of insects or disease.

Clean work areas, and maintain grounds and landscaping; gather and remove litter.

Haul and spread topsoil, fertilizer, peat moss, and other materials to condition soil, using wheelbarrows or carts and shovels.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

The ability to exert maximum muscle force to lift, push, pull or carry objects. The ability to bend, stretch, twist, or reach with your body, arms, and/or legs. Ability to follow simple oral and/or written instructions. Develop constructive and cooperative working relations with others.

Physical Demands:

Regularly walk, stand, stoop, or bend; occasionally lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects weighing up to 25 pounds; regularly use tools or equipment requiring manual dexterity; and work for sustained period of time outdoors.

Work Environment:

Work is performed in an outdoor setting with exposure to heat, rain and cold temperatures.

Education and Experience:

No experience required.

Individual may be subject to and must pass a physical, drug test and background check.
