Chippewa Road & Calvin Drive Sanitary & Storm Sewer Improvements

The project is advancing and the storm and sanitary sewer installation along Chippewa Road is complete from Riverview to Calvin. The contractor is restoring the pavement section with the intent to tentatively start west of Calvin Drive next week. Storm and sanitary sewer installation along Calvin Drive is also complete with the exception a few feet needed to abandon the Glen Valley Pump Station. As a reminder until the project is completed, and the City accepts the sewer, resident connections to the sewers are not permitted.

Streambank Stabilization Project Chippewa Creek at Millside Shopping Center

The Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District with Great Lakes Construction, will be performing the final stages of the Streambank stabilization along Chippewa Creek at Millside Shopping Center. An approximate and tentative schedule was provided which involves the following work to be performed. Please be mindful, all dates are subject to delay due to weather.

- Tree clearing to be completed by March 31, 2023
- Lowering of waterline to begin May 1, 2023, with an approximate duration of 45 days.
- Boulder placement for erosion control to begin May 15, 2023, with an approximate duration of 10 days.
- Retaining wall construction on north side of Chippewa Creek to start July 1, 2023, with an approximate duration of 45 days.
- Storm sewer work to start August 15, 2023, with an approximate duration of 10 days.
- They plan to have the site restored by the end of October 2023.

This project will stabilize a failing stretch of Chippewa Creek streambank at Millside Center.
