ENTRANCE RAMP CLOSURE

There may be times over Monday, February 6th and Tuesday, February 7th that the north bound entrance ramp to I-77 at Miller Road will be closed to traffic due to the construction project at this interchange. We suggest it best you avoid relying on this north bound ramp for entry onto I-77, and seek an alternate route, be it the ramps at I-77 and 82, I-77 and the County line, or the Wallings Road entrance.



NATURAL GAS AND ELECTRICITY UPDATE

NOPEC lowered its 2-year fixed rate from \$6.36 to \$5.49. If you have the \$6.36 rate or higher call NOPEC immediately at 1-855-667-3201 and ask to be switched to the \$5.49 rate. However, if you are with a company other than NOPEC for gas you might have an early termination fee. Ask about that before switching to NOPEC. Your meter reading typically happens on the day of the month that you see at the top of the bill where it says "Date Prepared." A rate change does not take place until after a meter reading and many of you are coming up on a meter reading in the next week or so. If you don't do this before your February meter reading it won't be until March for the change to take place. As they say, operators are standing by!

As you know just about all NOPEC electricity customers were automatically sent back to the Illuminating Company's "Price to Compare" which is a monthly variable rate currently at 5.46 cents per kWh.
