We will be holding a public hearing prior to Council Committee Meetings on Tuesday, May 2 at 5:50pm, in regards to an application to the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) through their congestion mitigation air quality program for funding to design, engineer, and construct a multi-use trail or sidewalks, and a transit waiting environment, on Brecksville Road from Valley Parkway to Miller Road.
