Our drug take back will be held this Saturday, April 30th from 10:00AM until 2:00PM at the Brecksville Horticultural Building at 6916 Stadium Drive. This is a collaboration with the Drug Enforcement Bureau (DEA), Brecksville and Broadview Heights Police Departments and the Brecksville and Broadview Heights CERT Team. These collection programs, DEA National Takeback, protect our children, our water and our food supplies, and decrease prescription drug abuse by making it easier for you to properly dispose of unused or expired medication. This is a completely confidential program. No personal information will be collected. Please remove all prescription labels before arriving. This program is sponsored by the Brecksville-Broadview Heights CAPA organization

Polls are open 6:30AM until 7:30PM. This is a state wide primary election day. Other than the state and county primary candidates, the City of Brecksville voters will consider two Zoning Amendments:

Issue 2 Proposed Zoning Amendment

A 55% affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall the Zoning Map of the City of Brecksville be amended to change the classification of PP#'s 602-13-017 and 602-13-018 located at 10909 Chippewa Road from R-20 Single Family District to O-B Office Building District?

Issue 3 Proposed Zoning Amendment

A 55% affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall the zoning map of the City of Brecksville be amended to change the classification of PP#'s 601-33-002 and 601-33-003 located at 8997 Highland Drive from R-8 Single Family District to C-F Community Facilities District
