Brecksville City Council will hold a Special Meeting of Council to reconsider the request of Welty-Gilbane Construction to begin concrete pouring and concrete finishing at 4:00 am due to our weather conditions. The meeting will begin at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, August 9th, in the Ralph Biggs Council Chambers. This is a one item agenda special meeting. Representatives of Sherwin-Williams and Welty-Gilbane will be present and will address City Council and the public.



We hope you are continuing to cope with the unusual warm weather and humidity. Drinking water, wearing light clothing, exercising and completing yard work during the cooler times of day, if possible, are keys to coping to these weather conditions. Please exercise caution.



Per our City Charter, the Mayor shall appoint a Charter Review Commission by September 1, 2022. Nine citizen members are to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council, along with one alternate member. To be qualified to serve you must be a resident of the City of Brecksville and you must not be currently serving on any other boards or commissions, or be employed by the City. Anyone wishing to apply should submit their resume to City Hall at receptionist@brecksville.oh.us, care of the Mayor's Office, by Monday, August 15th. The Commission will begin its work in September of this year and will submit its recommendations to City Council by June of 2023. Those recommendations, if any, will be placed on the November 2023 ballot for consideration by the Brecksville electorate. City Council is required to place on the ballot any and all recommendations of the Charter Review Commission. All commission meetings are open to the public. Please do not hesitate providing your resume to City Hall if you have an interest in this appointment. Applications cannot be accepted after August 16th
