Today, our Service Department encountered a dangerous situation due to someone camouflaging hazardous materials within paint cans. A mixture of fuel oil, a small propane container and Bunsen burners, which were emitting gas, were disposed of in paint cans marked “water-based paint.” Please, if you have hazardous materials to discard, notify our Service Department and we will tell you the proper way to dispose of them within our City Recycling Program.

The Southwest Suburban Hazardous Materials Team was called to our Recycling Center because upon first inspection our staff was unable to determine these materials. They were tested by HAZMAT and they informed the City of their contents. Fortunately, our employee who had the mixture of materials emitted from the can onto his person suffered no ill effects. The City does recycle hazardous materials and there is no reason for someone to mask hazardous materials by placing them in containers with markings of non-hazardous materials. Propane tanks and fuel oil are a dangerous mixture. Please help us keep our staff safe.
