March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 through March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022 is recognized as “Severe Weather Awareness Week”, and as we are entering this time, we call upon our residents to be aware of recommended guidelines when a tornado warning is issued and how best to protect yourself and your family in the event of a tornado. We will be testing our tornado sirens tomorrow, Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 pm. Our emergency sirens/tornado sirens, are tested on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of each month from March to October. Also, this weekend specifically March 5<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 pm noon, along with the emergency siren testing, we will test our CODE RED Emergency Notification System, which is normally tested on the first Saturday in March and then again in October.
