The tragic and shocking events at the Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas underscores again the vulnerability of the people of our nation and nations throughout the world. We especially are shocked at the attack upon our most susceptible and weak, the children. Our city offers it prayers and sympathy to families of the deceased.

As Mayor and Safety Director, I assure you that our city school district of Brecksville-Broadview Heights has made the safety of our children and staff one of its utmost responsibilities. Major safety protocols were introduced within the district and our two cities law enforcement departments heightened by the Columbine tragedy in the year 2009. This endeavor is ongoing and with the pending opening of the new Elementary School this fall, a facility designed with heightened security, A Police Student Resource Officer (SRO), and state of the art systems and training; security of Students and Staff a paramount element of its design.

Yesterday, today and tomorrow, May 25, 26, 27, our police have demonstrated their presence and concern by being on property and highly visible to our community, emphasis to and for our students, families and school staff. School Superintendent Magyar reached out to the law enforcement community seeking their clear presence at our schools.

- Zoning Map Amendment from Community Facilities CF to R20, Single Family Residential at 9457 Highland Drive (Highland Drive Elementary School)

The Public Hearing for Central School rezoning has been cancelled as the Planning Commission will be reviewing the creation of a new and separate zoning classification different from our current classifications for this property.
