There will be a ceremony followed by an opportunity for those selected in our raffle to experience the features showcased in these facilities. That will be followed by an opportunity to tour the new facilities. Cookies and punch will be served. It is open to the public and we welcome you back to enjoy seeing these new Brecksville family water facilities. If the Community Center lot is full, Overflow Parking will be at the Library, Christ the Redeemer Lutheran Church and the City Hall parking lot. The event tours will conclude at 3:00 p.m.

Entry will be restricted to those Early Members during specific admittance time periods.
