### **Brecksville City Council Meeting**

Tuesday, June 2nd, City Council will resume holding, and continue to hold its regularly scheduled meetings in the Ralph W. Biggs Council Chambers at Brecksville City Hall. At 7:00 pm City Council will assemble in the chambers for Committee Meetings, and thereafter, at 8:00 pm, hold its regularly scheduled Council meeting with the following protocols.

- If you are not feeling well, please do not attend, if you are exhibiting symptoms, you will be asked to leave.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use.
- Masks will be required unless there is a health risk. If you do not have a mask, we will be providing them for you.
- All attendees will be required to provide a name and contact information-in the event contact tracing is needed.
- Seating is limited, distancing will be adhered to with a minimum of six feet between people. If the room reaches capacity, standing room will be afforded in the lobby of City Hall.

We will continue to live stream City Council meetings during this time and make them accessible to the public on Facebook. You do NOT need a Facebook account to listen to the meeting live. ### **Board of Zoning Appeals Meeting June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

Board of Zoning Appeals will meet via teleconference on Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, at 7:30pm. Only members of the Board, and those presented will be calling-into the meeting. The audio of the meeting will be live streamed on Facebook, and a link will be posted on the BZA page on the City website. Board of Zoning Appeals will resume in person meetings and follow distancing protocols beginning in July.

### **Community Center and Recreation Programs**

On Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> the Community Center will reopen with a revised schedule of Monday through Friday from 5:30 am to 8:00 pm, and Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm.

- The fitness center and free weight area will be reopened and all will be required to follow the distancing protocol.
- Fitness classes will be announced, they too will require distancing.
- The Natatorium will be reopened with only one swimmer per lap.
- Unfortunately, the Field House Gymnasium and Community Rooms will not be reopened at this time.
- The locker rooms will be open with every third locker being made available for use to allow for proper 6ft social distancing, but the saunas and showers will be closed.
- Child Care will be open Monday through Friday 8:30am-2pm; Monday through Thursday 4-8pm, and Saturday 10am-1pm. It will limited to 6 children, reservations are required by calling the Community Center 440 546-2300.
- Restrooms at the baseball fields and tennis courts will only be open during scheduled games.
- As of this e-mail playgrounds have yet to be reopened. We are hoping for this announcement in the weeks to come and will notify the public right away.

A brochure highlighting the City protocols and policies, to comply with the Board of Health requirements, is attached to this email, and will also be available online for your review. Please familiarize yourself with this information prior to your return to the Community Center.

Any resident who wishes to utilize the Community Center, or be part of any of the city programs, will be required to sign an acknowledgment waiver that too will be posted on the City web page. A copy of the waiver is attached to this email, please print, review, sign it and bring it with you upon your return to the Community Center.

For questions regarding credits for any cancelled program that you had already paid for or if you would like to request a refund, please email [WebTrac@brecksville.oh.us](mailto:WebTrac@brecksville.oh.us) and include your name, address, and what programs you were signed up for. . Refund requests must be received by Friday June 26th. Refunds do not include membership fees, only household credits will be issued for memberships based on the number of days the Community Center was closed.

### **Safety Town**

In 1972, the Brecksville Police Department began one of the first Safety Town Programs in Northeast Ohio, and it is with a heavy heart the City must cancel this years program. ### **Aquatic Expansion Project**

The Outdoor Aquatics and Natatorium expansion continues its construction with delays due to certain construction material deliveries coming from other states and their protocols as it regards to the coronavirus. A tentative dedication ceremony is being planned for August. We will keep you informed of these plans via these e-mails and the City web page.

### **Home Days**

As a reminder, Home Days has been canceled. The City is hoping to have a fireworks display in the next coming months. We will, as always, send any information to you via e-mail and City website.



We hope all will realize that our protocols and policies may be changing as each day the Governor and Board of Health, in response to questions from communities and residents, more specifically outline the protocols. Therefore, we ask for your patience. We will continue to revise these policies as required and post the information on the City web page and via these emails.
