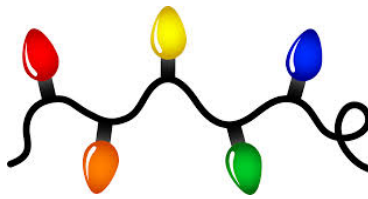
City Hall has new hours. The building will now open on Monday through Friday at 8:30AM and close at 4:30PM.
