This Thursday, October 8, from 8:00am to 12:00 noon, the Community Center will be closed. We are required to set-up a crane on the main driveway to complete a phase of our construction. We are sorry for the inconvenience. The good news, the project is winding down and should be completed by mid-November. We thank you for your cooperation. The Grab & Go Lunch at Human Services has NOT been cancelled and will go on as planned. Personnel will be on hand to direct you.

On Friday, October 9, during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., our Service Department will be making road surface repairs to State Route 82 East of Route 21 (Chippewa Road). We will maintain traffic with a posted detour down Wiese Road to Riverview Road. Truck traffic will be permitted to proceed through the detour. Please try to avoid this area, if possible. Local traffic, of course, will be accommodated. This project shall take only these hours on Friday. Also on Friday, milling will take place on the Community Center Parking Lot. The building will remain open. Please adhere to the direction given to you for parking by the contractor and/or our City staff. We apologize also for this inconvenience. Please use caution in utilizing the parking lot this Friday.

Then on Saturday, October 10, from sunrise to sunset, the paving contractor for the State Route 82 East and West between Ken Mar Industrial Parkway to Broadview Road will be reduced to one lane traveling east and one lane traveling west, as they put complete final paving of this roadway expansion project. We strongly recommend you avoid this area of roadway. Delays will take place due to traffic congestion and back-up. The pavement widening phase of the Route 82 Project between the cities of Brecksville and Broadview Heights will soon be completed. The sidewalks will be installed in 2021. This has been a much needed improvement and will certainly limit future congestion

in this section of the 82 corridor. I know all of this work, as previously stated, will cause congestion, delays, and an inconvenience to you, but these projects all are much needed and will improve parking and traffic flow in the areas that are part of these projects. Please drive safely and if you are unable to avoid these areas, have patience and pay close attention to any instructions you are given.

I will end this simply by saying it is better to avoid these areas than to confront the construction zones.



Last evening, the newly installed audio/visual equipment in Council Chambers was utilized. We are very pleased with the results. The audio/video link to the public will continue throughout the days ahead as we deal with the Covid-19 pandemic. We appreciate the work of Myles Rapkin, his team and members of the Service Department. Please watch our schedule of City meetings on the webpage and announcements on Facebook if you are interested in viewing meetings of City Council. City Council meets on the first and third Tuesday of the month. Committees meet any time from 5:30 p.m. onto the start of the regular City Council meeting at 8:00 p.m. We encourage you to view both City Council Committees, as well as the regular meeting of City Council. Soon other equipment will be installed in our City buildings to automatically monitor the body temperature of those entering the buildings and other equipment continuing to create distancing for the safety of those who utilize our facilities as well as of course our staff.
